

2014 HOLY CROSS RECTOR SEARCH PARISH SURVEY

WHAT IS YOUR AGE?





WHAT IS YOUR ZIP CODE?




HOW MANY TIMES PER MONTH DO YOU WORSHIP AT HOLY CROSS?

WHICH SERVICES DO YOU USUALLY ATTEND?






WHAT FIRST BROUGHT YOU TO HOLY CROSS?




WHY HAVE YOU CONTINUED ATTENDING HOLY CROSS?




HOW IMPORTANT ARE THE VARIOUS ASPECTS OF A WORSHIP SERVICE TO YOU?


WOULD YOU PREFER THE SAME AMOUNT OF RITUAL AND CEREMONY AS WE CURRENTLY HAVE?
