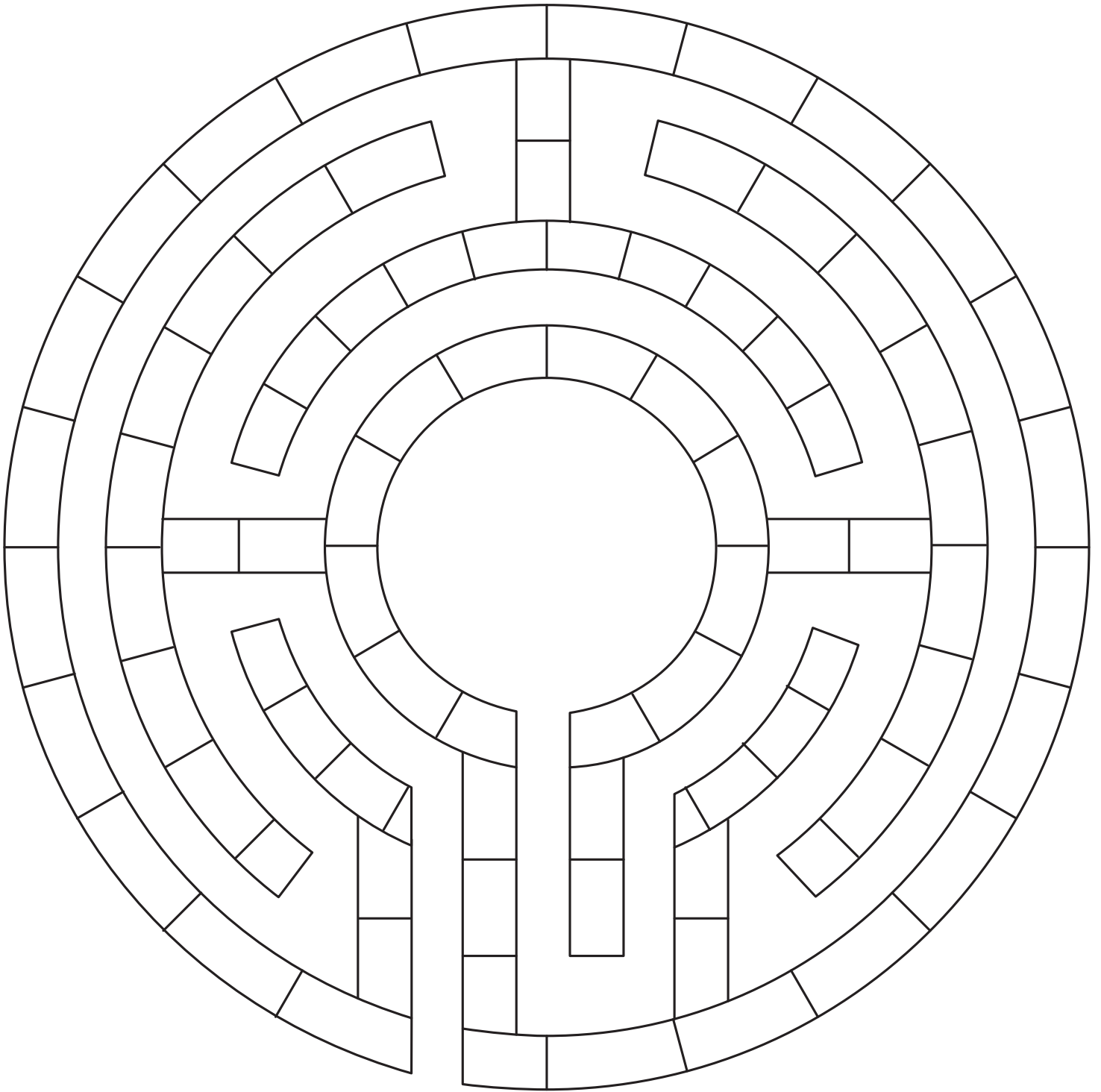

Walking in Love, Praying in Color

Every year, we ask members of the Church of the Holy Cross to prayerfully consider their pledge to our parish. Prayer can take many forms. We invite you to explore a contemplative and creative practice called “praying in color” during this fall’s annual giving campaign as a way to deepen your conversation with God.

This coloring sheet is yours to use as you want. We invite you to color, write words, or doodle on this page as you pray for your household’s pledge and your hopes and dreams for our parish’s future.

There are lots of ways to pray in color! If you’re looking for a prayer to use, consider the “Prayer for My Church” that is included in this mailing. If you are looking for ideas on which colors to use, consider the following colors and their typical associations:

- **Red**: love, passion, prosperity, and happiness
- **Pink**: unconditional love, understanding, sincerity, and nurturing
- **Orange**: creativity, change, health, and vitality
- **Yellow**: sunshine, hope, and courage
- **Green**: new beginnings, growth, abundance, stability, and renewal
- **Light Blue**: health, healing, tranquility, understanding, and softness
- **Blue**: peace, calmness, loyalty, and responsibility
- **Purple**: creativity, imagination, and wealth
- **Brown**: dependability, steadfastness, reliability, and warmth
- **Black**: authority, certainty, power, and decisiveness
